School Review Process:

Step 1: Planning the Review:

Step 3: Summarising the Data:

The findings are reported in a meeting with stakeholders and presented in a form that can be interpreted readily by all key leaders.

Step 4: Planning for Improvement

Development of an action plan

(EXCERPT) Best Teaching Practices

The instructor creates a welcoming, supportive environment.
